The primary goal of the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) is to promote compliance once the law becomes effective. To help achieve this, IDPH will focus on educating the public and business owners about the statewide smoke free air law.

IDPH is in the process of writing Administrative rules to provide guidance on the enforcement provisions of the law.

The Administrative Rules have not been finalized.
