FUEL TAX CREDIT SCAMS

The IRS is receiving claims for fuel tax credit that are unreasonable. Some taxpayers, such as farmers who use fuel for off-highway business purposes, may be eligible for the fuel tax credit. But some individuals are claiming the tax credit for nontaxable uses of fuel when their occupation or income level makes the claim unreasonable. Fraud involving the fuel tax credit was recently added to the list of frivolous was recently added to the list of frivolous tax claims, potentially subjecting those who improperly claim the credit to a \$5,000 penalty.
